# CCA Choice & Allocation Phase

- After the trials, students will select their **top five** CCA choices for allocation.
- Students will key in these five choices on the InCAMPUS website.
- There will be a user interface briefing on the InCAMPUS website on **27 January**.
- Students must make their top five CCA choices and submit their **CCA choices online** via the InCAMPUS website between **27 to 29 January**.
- Do indicate on InCAMPUS website, if you wish to represent schools in other areas e.g. Wushu, Taekwondo, Bowling etc.
